## **Welcome back!**

We are really looking forward to an exciting year full of lots of fantastic learning. This term our topic in Year 3 will be 'The Stone Age to Iron Age'.

## English

One of the books we will be reading this term is The Three Little Pigs. This is a perfect text to help children in their understanding of how to use story language to retell a popular tale. The children will be developing techniques such as using adjectives, expanded noun phrases and recapping on how to use capital letters and full-stops.

We look forward to reading high quality texts with the children and developing their inference, comprehension, prediction and summarising skills.

Please try to read with your child for 10 minutes each day. This will really help to improve not only their reading skills but also their writing skills.

## Science

This term, our science topic is 'Animals, including humans'. Throughout this topic, children will be taught to identify that animals including humans need the right types and amount of nutrition and about balanced diets. We will also be learning about skeletons and muscles and their purpose.

## Topic

This term we will be learning about The Stone Age to the Iron Age. We will be discovering fascinating facts about the life of Stone Age people, where they lived, what they ate and what they looked like. We will also learn about the tools and weapons they made and their survival alongside creatures such as the woolly mammoth.

The children will also be completing a daily Rock Stars times tables test focusing on the 3, 4 and 8 times tables. Please practise at home.
