- Research the foods that Anglo Saxons and present your findings as a drawing or a fact file
- Prove by using evidence (e.g. pictures, facts) what a person's life in Anglo Saxon times may have been like
- Sketch or create a 3D model of an Anglo Saxon house.
- Design and make a piece of Anglo Saxon weaponry.
- Create an information page about an aspect of Anglo Saxon life which interests you the most - you could present it as a powerpoint presentation.
- Design a Beowulf t-shirt - you could draw your design onto a plain white t-shirt!
- Make a sketch of an Anglo Saxon artefact then write some information about it.
