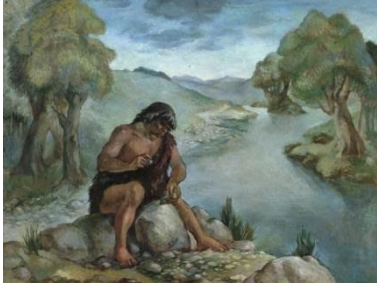


Year 6 Home Learning
