Maths

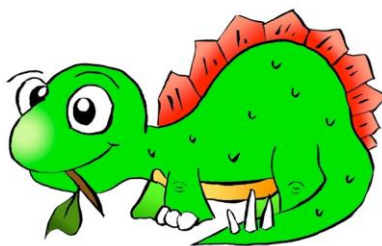
- Counting forwards and backwards to and through 100.
