Computing

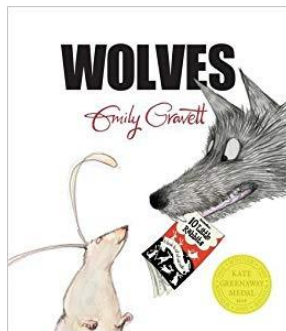
- learning to keep our personal details safe online
