Science

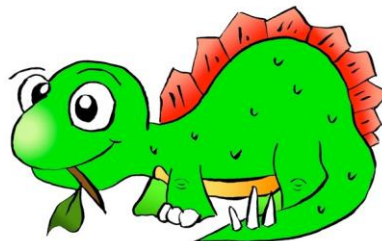
- Learning about herbivores, omnivores and carnivores.
