

Year 2 Home Learning Term 5

Living and Growing

Our Topic this term is called 'Living and Growing'. Every Friday, children will be given one piece of English home learning, one piece of maths home learning, spellings and handwriting to be completed by the following Wednesday. This will follow on from the learning that has been done in class and that will allow your child to practise applying their new knowledge to different activities.

Children that hand Home Learning in on time will be rewarded with stickers!

As well as this, each term children will be given a project based on their class topic. This can be completed in the children's own time and shared with the class at the end of the term!

Home Learning Project

Our topic for science this term is focusing on plants. This week children have planted their own sunflower seeds into a pot. The aim of this project is to allow children to understand what plants need to grow. They will need to water their seeds/plant when the soil is dry until the end of term. Children with the healthiest plant will be rewarded with a prize at the end of term.

Along with this, your child will be provided with a sunflower diary booklet, which needs to be filled in each week. This will involve drawing a picture of what their plant looks like; explain what they have done to look after their plant, count how many leaves are on their plant and measuring the height of the plant.
