- Create a sketch or painting of an iconic location in Tanzania.
- Research/find out about a city in Tanzania. Be creative about how you present your information.
- Cook a dish from Tanzania (with an adult). Take pictures and/or write up a recipe.
- Learn a song in Swahili.
- Carry out an investigation exploring solids, liquids and gases and present the findings.
- Create a poster/presentation about the Water Cycle.
- Create a game around the theme of solids, liquids and gases.
