- Create a sketch or painting of a UK or European city scape
- Research/find out about a city in Europe. Be creative about how you present your information.
- Cook a dish from European country (with an adult) Take pictures, write up a recipe.
- Learn a song in a different European language.
- Read and retell a story from a different European culture.
- Create a map of your local area.
- Carry out an investigation exploring solids, liquids and gases and present the findings.
- Create a poster/presentation about the Water Cycle
