- Draw yourself as an Athenian or Spartan. Label your picture with accurate adjectives.
- Design and create a leaflet persuading people to visit Athens or Sparta.
- Find out about the Olympic games and present your findings in an interesting way - you could print your information on a white T-shirt or make a poster etc
