 - Design a T-shirt to show the life-cycle of a living thing.
 - Write a diary entry about a visit to one of the habitats below.
 - Create a fun fact page on habitats. You could include a crossword puzzle, riddle etc.
- Produce a piece of art on an animal, its habitat or both. You could use collage, paint, or just pencil.
