**This term, our topic will be Mexico and we will be learning about the geography, food and people of the country.**


**We'll also be learning all about Light in our Science lessons. English and Maths will continue to be a high focus.**

## English

In our English lessons we will be basing our writing on the book 'The Tunnels Below' by Nadine Wild-Palmer, covering a range of genres, including Descriptive writing, adverts, information texts and diary entries. We will use our Mexico topic as a basis for further writing, including writing about different Mexican festivals and food. There will be a strong emphasis on grammar, spelling, punctuation and handwriting. Whole Class Reading will be taught on a daily basis.



## Maths

In Maths we will be focusing on a range of different objectives, using the Power Maths scheme of work. We will mainly be looking at Number, Measurement and Geometry. We will also be focusing on applying this knowledge when solving problems. Mental arithmetic will be taught alongside this on a weekly basis. It would be of great benefit if you could practise the times tables with your child regularly.

## Science

This term, our science topic is 'Light'. Throughout this topic, children will be taught how light travels in straight lines and will investigate shadows (how their shape and size changes). As well as our practical investigations, we will look at how we can use what we have learnt to make good shadow puppet plays.

## Topic

For our topic, we will be learning all about Mexico: physical characteristics, food, festivals and what daily life is like. We will also be using this as an opportunity to learn Spanish vocabulary for food.

We will be using our work on Mexican food to run a Mexican Masterchef-style challenge for the children towards the end of term.
