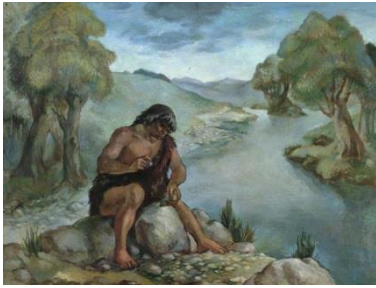


Year 6 Home Learning

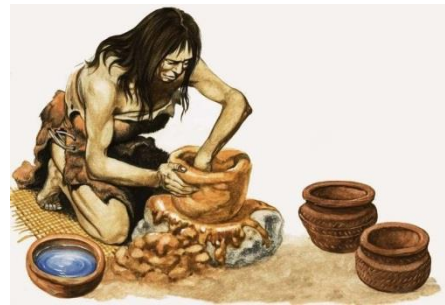


Every Friday, children will be given one piece of English Home Learning and one piece of Maths Home Learning to be completed by the following Wednesday.

Home Learning Project

Our topic this term is Prehistory Mysteries

We are looking at the Stone Age to the Iron Age, and looking at developments and changes through time.

Your project this term is to choose from the following activities:

- Design and make your own cave painting from the Stone Age.
- Design and make your own Bronze Age artefact eg shield, tools etc.
- Draw, describe or make an Iron Age fort or village

Our text this term is Cogheart

As a follow-up to reading Cogheart, you may want to:

- Design and make your own airship: What can you make it out of? E.g. balloons, old washing up liquid bottles, Does it have any special features? Is there a design on the side?
- Make a trailer for Cogheart: How much information will you include in order to create suspense without giving too much away?
- Design your own fictional world, based on a real historical period you have covered (or maybe the Stone Age, Bronze Age or Iron Age!)
