Children that hand Home Learning in on time will be rewarded with stickers!

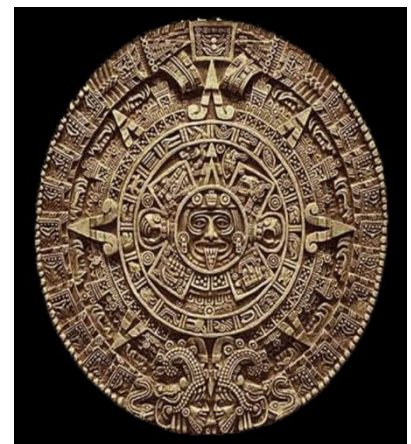
As well as this, each term children will be given a project based on their class topic. This can be completed in the children's own time and shared with the class at the end of the term!

- Make a headdress of a Mayan ruler (remember the bigger it is, the more important you are!)



You can present your work in any way you like. It could be:

- a presentation
- annotated drawings
- a prototype of model
- sketches of all your ideas
- A booklet
