

## Communication and Language + Literacy:

### Reading:

- Uses vocabulary and forms of speech that are increasingly influenced by their experiences of books.
- Enjoys an increasing range of books .
- Knows that information can be retrieved from books and computers.

### Writing:

- Hears and says the initial sounds in words.
- Can segment the sounds in simple words and blend them together.

### Speaking,listening and understanding:

- Listens to others one to one in a small groups, or when conversation interests them.
- Responds to instructions involving a two-part sequence.
- Listens and responds to ideas expressed by others in conversation or discussion.

## • Physical Development

- Experiments with different ways of moving.
- Jumps off an object and lands correctly.
- Negotiates space successfully when playing racing and chasing games with other children, adjusting speed or changing direction to avoid obstacles.
- Travels with skill and confidence around, under, over and through balancing and climbing equipment.
- Shows a preference for a dominant hand.

## Mathematics

- Recognises some numerals of personal significance.
- Counts an irregular arrangement of up to 10 objects
- Recognises numerals 1 to 5.
- Counts up to three objects which cannot be moved..
- Counts objects to 10, and beginning to count beyond 10.
- Counts up to six objects from a larger group.
- Uses the language of 'more' and 'fewer' to compare two sets of objects.
- Begins to identify own mathematical problems based on own interests and fascinations.
- Orders two or three objects by length or height..
- Orders two items by weight or capacity.

## Personal, Social & Emotional Development

- Initiates conversations, attends to and takes account of what others say.
- confident to speak to others about own needs, wants, interests and opinions.
- Aware of the boundaries set, and of behavioural expectations in the setting.

## Understanding the World + ICT

- Knows some of the things that make them unique, and can talk about some of the similarities and differences in relation to friends or family.
- Talks about why things happen and how things work.
- Knows that information can be retrieved from computers.

## Expressive Arts & Design

- Taps out simple repeated rhythms.
- Explores the different sounds of instruments.
- Explore what happens when they mix colours.
- Understand that different media can be combined to create new effects.
