Writing:

- Practise letter formation.

Speaking and listening:

Maths

- Counting and recognising numbers to 20
- Saying one more or one less than a given number
- Adding and subtracting in practical situations
- Develop and use language to describe position and direction
- Using art to recognise and explore patterns
- Using language related to money, through role play

Physical Development

- Experiment with different ways of moving and adjusting speed and direction through whole class games.
- Handling tools safely with increasing control
- Fine motor control - practice using scissors and developing the correct pencil grip, through fine motor activities.
