Oh my goodness! What is that?



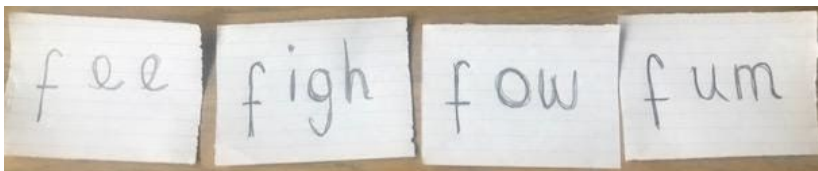
Fee-figh-fow-fum.

Write the 'giant' words on bits of paper.



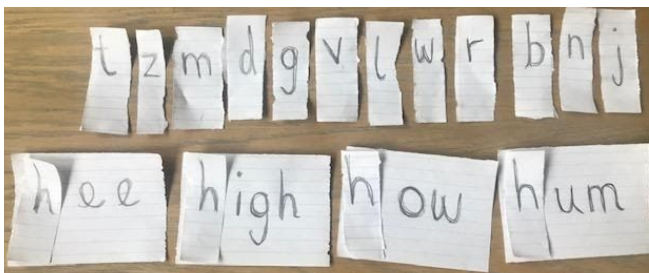
Note for parents and carers:

/ee/ - what can you see

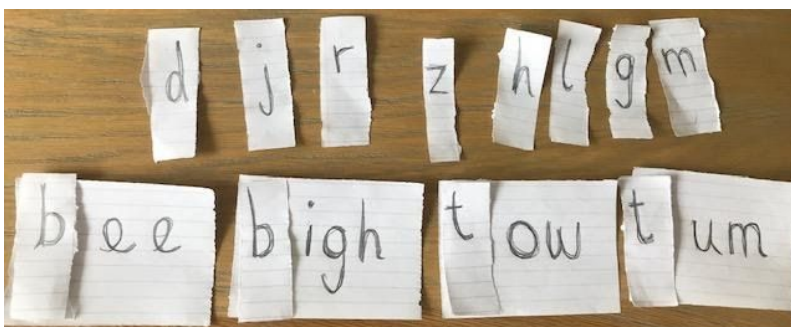
/igh/ - fly high
