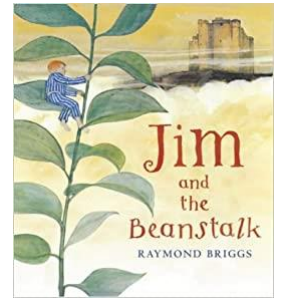




Can you make another puppet for the giant character? Act out this part of the story with your puppets. You could make glasses and teeth for the giant!

An old giant! He looks scary but I'm starving. I'll run away if he tries to eat me.



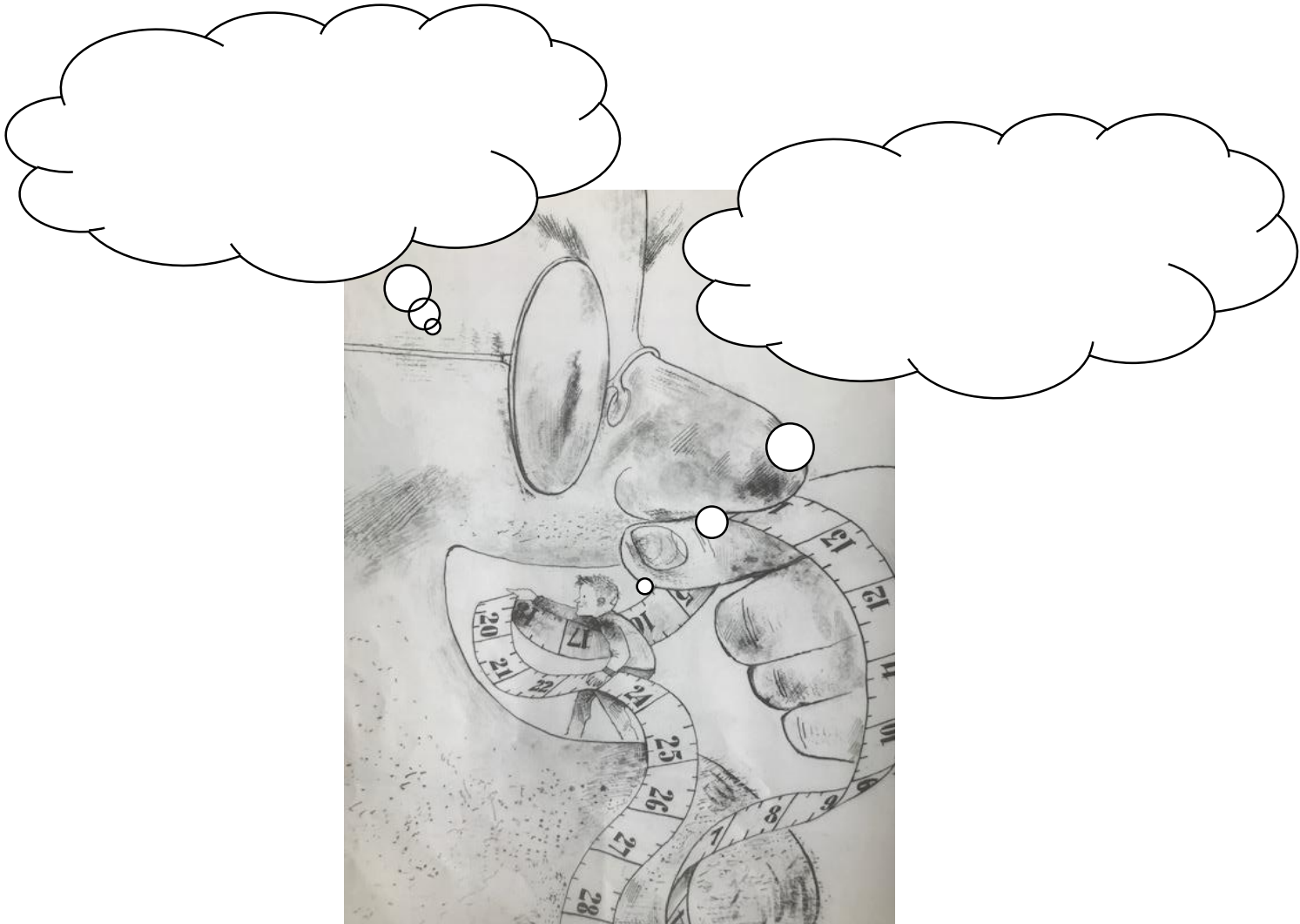
We do not always say exactly what we think.

- Why might Jim not say what he was thinking?







What do you think the characters are **thinking** when Jim is measuring the giant's mouth to get him new teeth?
