Following instructions

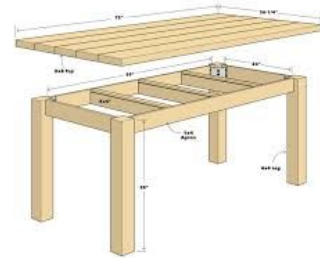
Today we are going to be following **instructions**.

How to make a jam sandwich

Today we are going to follow instructions to make a jam sandwich.

You will need:

- 2 slices of bread
- butter or margarine
- jam
- a plate
- a children's knife (not sharp)



How to make a jam sandwich

Instructions:

1. First wash your hands with soap and water.
2. Next get two slices of bread and use a knife to spread the butter over one side of each slice of bread.
3. Then use the knife to spread the jam over the butter on one slice of the bread.
4. After that put the slice of the bread without the jam on top of the other slice.
5. Finally cut the sandwich in half.
6. Enjoy your sandwich and don't forget to wash up!!


