slice put add

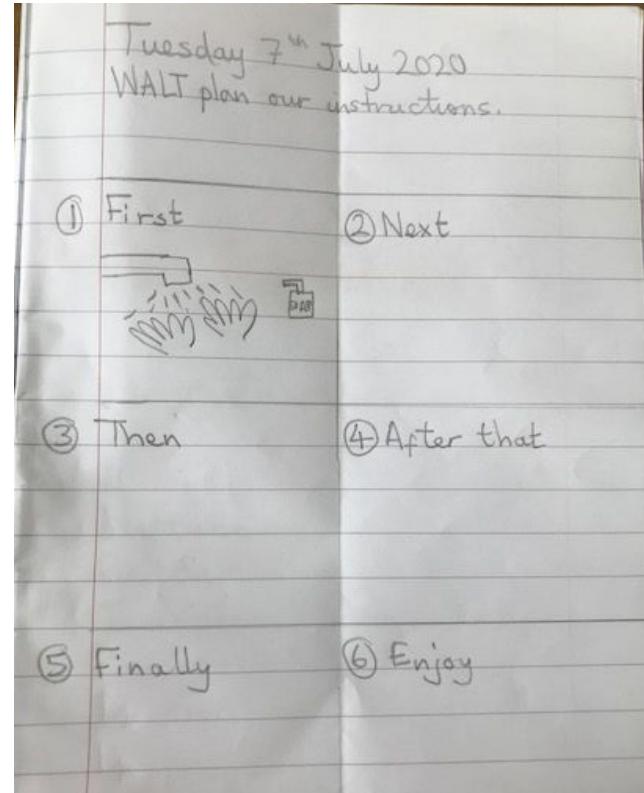
pour sprinkle cut


