Please do **NOT** do the lessons planned for Reading, Maths, SPaG and Maths. These will be covered in school when your child is in. The planning and tasks are only uploaded for those children who are continuing to be homeschooled all the time.

eg If your child returns to school in week A , then they are to complete the Oak Academy tasks in week B. If your child returns to school in week B, then they are to complete the Oak Academy tasks in week A.

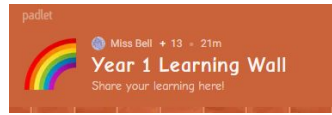
#### **For children continuing to homeschool all the time**

If your child is **not** returning to school, please complete these lessons **one** week and the Oak Academy lessons in the **other**.

eg. In one week your child is to complete the tasks set online, like they have been until now. During the second week they are to complete the Oak Academy tasks. You can choose which 'week' you do first.

## A few reminders



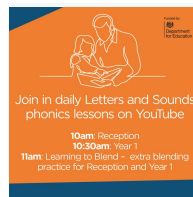
