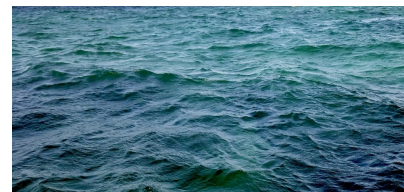
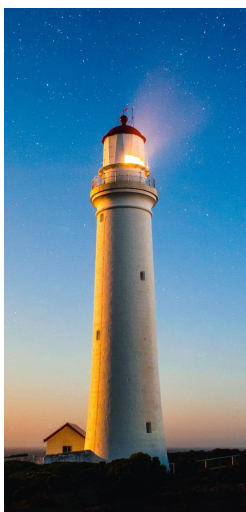
| Adjectives | | | | |

| colour | size | shape | texture | feeling |
| blue | big | round | fluffy | happy |
| grey | small | flat | slimy | excited |
| orange | enormous | long | silky | scared |

- An **adjective** is a word that describes a noun (the name of a thing or a place).
- An **adjective** can describe the colour, size, shape, or texture of something.
- An **adjective** can describe someone's feelings
- An **adjective** can come before or after a noun.
