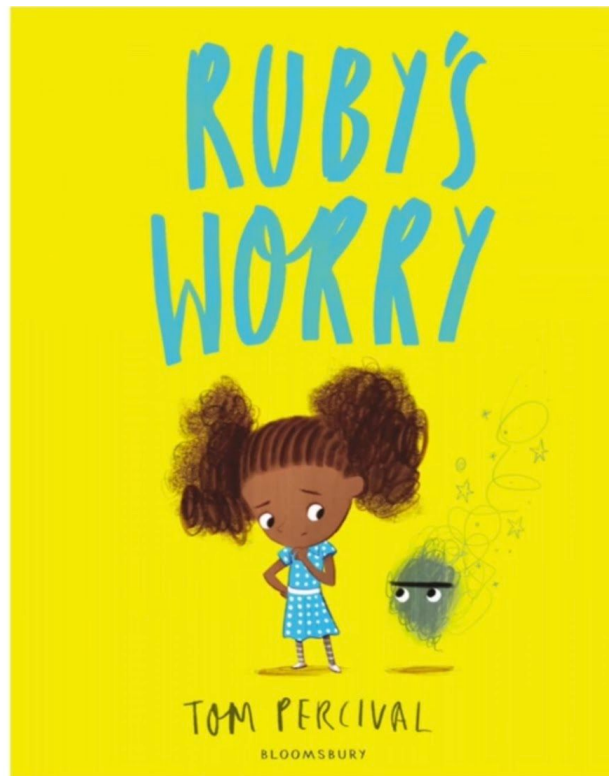


WALT listen and discuss a wide range of books
