will jump	jump	jumped
will climb	climb	climbed
will paint	paint	painted

- We use the **simple future tense** when we talk about something that hasn't happened yet.
- We use the **simple present tense** when we talk about something that is happening now.
- We use the **simple past tense** when we talk about something that has already happened.
