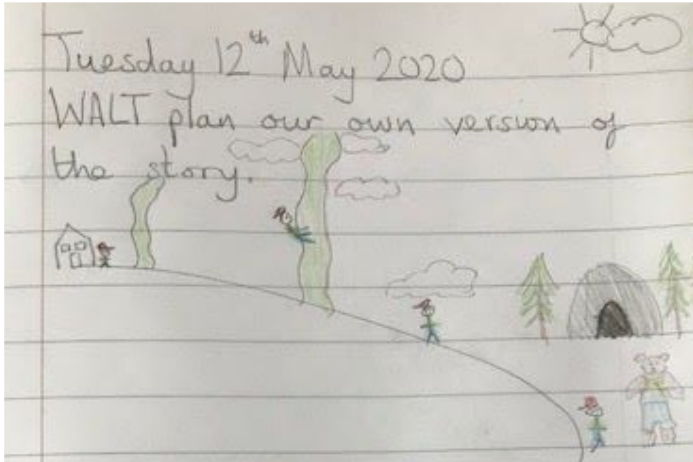


English Wednesday 13/05/20

opened








When you have practiced retelling the beginning of your story, write it in your purple book. Here's the beginning of my story:

One morning, Bill woke up and saw an enormous plant growing outside his window! He wanted to see how high it went so he climbed to the top of the plant.

When he reached the top, he saw a dark cave hidden in the trees. Bill ran to the cave and knocked on the door. A huge, brown bear opened the door! The bear said hello and invited Bill in for some breakfast.

Remember to:

- use your sounds to help you spell the words 
- use a finger space between each word 
- use a capital letter to start each sentence and full stop at the end  
- use an exclamation mark at the end of the sentence, if it is surprising, exciting or forceful 
- use the past tense (climb~~ed~~, look~~ed~~, open~~ed~~)



When you have finished writing, ask someone to help you read back through your work and check that you have included all the things above.
