WALT explore colours.



How many colours can you think of?

These colours are called **primary colours**. We can use these colours to make all other colours:



yellow



red



blue

These colours are called **secondary colours**:



orange



green



purple

We can use the primary colours to make the secondary colours.



- Which 2 primary colours do I need to mix together to make **orange**?
- Which 2 primary colours do I need to mix together to make **green**?
- Which 2 primary colours do I need to mix together to make **purple**?

Use your objects to make a colour pattern. You might want to make a rainbow or circle pattern like Gerard.
