
How amazing is the picture of the mosque?

Use dried beans, lentils, rice or even pasta to make a picture of the Islamic symbol of the crescent moon and star.



Challenge:

Make a lantern to decorate your house!

1. Take a piece of paper. You can decorate it, if you like.
2. Draw and cut a line from a shorter side to make the handle.





3. Fold the long side of the paper in half.




4. Cut from the fold along the short side of the paper, but don't cut all the way! Leave a finger space from the end.



5. Unfold the paper.



6. Glue the long side of the paper



7. Curve round the long side and stick to the other long side.



8. Stick the handle from one side to the other.



9. Enjoy your lantern!
