WALT publish our poem.



Well done for writing your own poem! I can't wait to read it.

Today we are going to **publish** our poem so we can share it with others.

First we need to think of a **title** for our poem. The **title** is what the poem is called. Think carefully about what your whole poem is about to give it a **title**. It could be something like 'My Garden' or 'Animals in the Garden'.



Now, write your **title** in the middle of the top line of a new page. Leave a blank line and start copying your poem on the next line. When you have finished, draw a picture underneath to show what it is about.

Remember to:

- use the correct **letter formation**
- use a finger space between each word
- start each new line with a **capital letter**
- write 'By: Your name'
