

We don't expect you to sit down all day to complete every lesson in one go. The lessons/tasks should be spread out during the day if possible. Don't forget to have mini movement breaks and enjoy some water and/or a healthy snack.

We expect the following time to be spent on the tasks we set:

Phonics- 10-15mins approx.

Maths- 30-45mins approx.

SPAG- 10-15mins approx.

Writing- 30-45mins approx.

Topic - 30-45mins approx

.Reading- 10-15mins approx.

Don't worry if you finish the task in less time. And if you find some of the tasks challenging and can't complete it in the time set - don't worry as long as you try your best!

Remember to enjoy yourself during your time at home and it is ok if you spend some of your time at home playing with your favourite toys or drawing and colouring in pictures.

If you do some fun cooking or making things at home you could take a photo of it (or draw a picture of it) and stick it in your books so that we can share it when we come back to school!

Or you could share it with the year group on the **Year 1 Learning Wall**.

We are using an APP called Padlet, which is an online bulletin board. We think this is a great way to share work and bring the school community together. The wall can only be seen by people who have been given the link below, which is shared with Year 1 pupils (parents and carers) at the school in this newsletter and in some learning tasks. All posts are checked and approved by us.

Learning Wall Rules:

- check with your parent or carer before you post
- don't write your name if you are in the photo
- only write your **first** name if you post a picture of your work or are writing a comment
- be kind if writing comments
- we approve all posts before they show up on the wall so you may have to wait before you can see your post!
