We have some great news, over the next few weeks we will be calling you all to see how you have been doing- we can't wait to hear all your familiar voices!

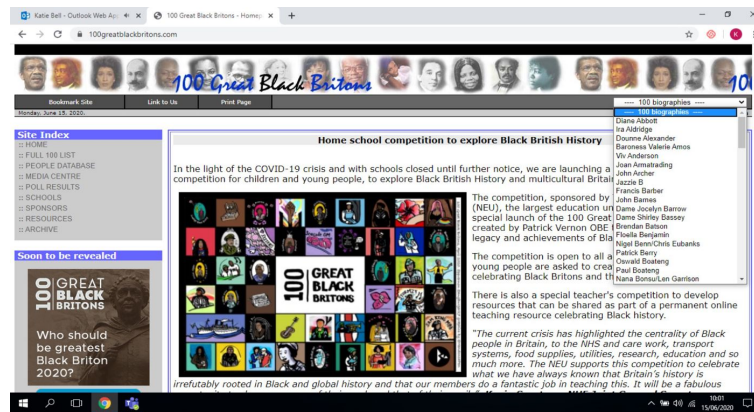
