 Write a diary entry pretending you are Mr. Grinling again. Write about what happened each day this week and how you felt about it.

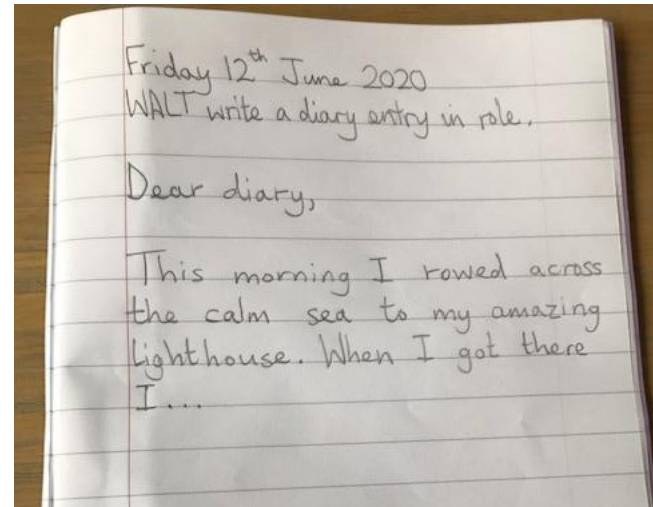
