**Prefix - un**

Word	Opposite
happy	<b>un</b> happy
helpful	<b>un</b> helpful
pack	<b>un</b> pack

- A **prefix** is a group of letters that are added before the word.
- A **prefix** changes the meaning of the word.
- We add the prefix **-un** before a word to make it the opposite.



**happy**



**un**happy
