The Islamic holy month of Ramadan began last Thursday night, 23rd April. Ramadan is an important time for Muslims all over the world.

Ramadan is a time to be kind to others and to do good deeds so today, we are going to make a daily kindness jar.



Can you think of 10 different acts of kindness?

Write each act of kindness on a small piece of paper and put it in a jar or box.

You could use the ones below or write your own:

1. Find ways to say 'please' and 'thank you'
2. Tell each of my family something I love about them
3. Make a thank you card for someone
4. Share with someone
5. Help set the table or wash the dishes
6. Be patient
7. Do something helpful without being asked
8. Be calm
9. Tidy my room without being asked
10. Think about how I can continue to be kind and generous

Each day, take out one piece of paper and read it. That is the act of kindness you will do that day. Ramadan lasts for 30 days. When you have done all 10 acts, put them back in the jar and start again. You will need to do each act on 3 different days.

### Challenge:

Why not decorate your jar or box? You can use glue to stick on a sign, a picture or even a collage. This is the one I made!
