WALT identify and name trees by looking at their leaves.

Look at the photos of 4 different types of leaves.



- Have you seen any of them before?
- Do any of them remind you of anything?
- Can you describe what they look like?
- What is the same and what is different about them?

Look carefully at the outline of each leaf and the lines inside.

Ash



Holly



Sycamore

Above are the names of the trees that the leaves belong to. You might want to ask an adult to help you read the last one!



Have a go at drawing 2 of them in your purple book. Write the name of the leaf under your drawing.



When you go on your daily walk, or if you have a garden, have a look to see if you can spot and name any of the leaves that we have learned about today.

- Can you see the tree that the leaf has come from?
- What does the tree look like?
- Did you see more than one of any of the trees?
- Did you see a leaf that we haven't learned about today? What did it look like? Can you take a photo or draw a picture of it and share it on our learning wall?
