There are two types of nouns:

- **Common nouns** are the names of things (types of people, animals, places or objects).
- **Proper nouns** are the names of a **particular** person, place or thing. They begin with a capital letter.

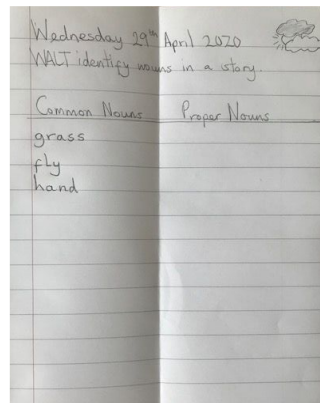


Can you hear any **common nouns** in the story?
