- Many **questions** start with the words 'who, what, where, when, why and how'.



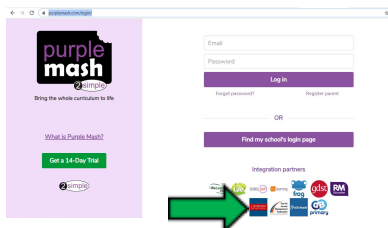
Remember:

- Look out for if it is something that is shocking or something that someone is shouting to see if it needs an exclamation mark at the end. !

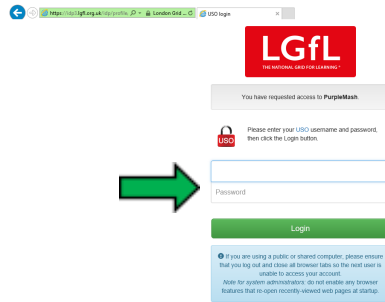
