Computing WALT use the rule of thirds to take a photograph

This week we will continue to learn about photography.

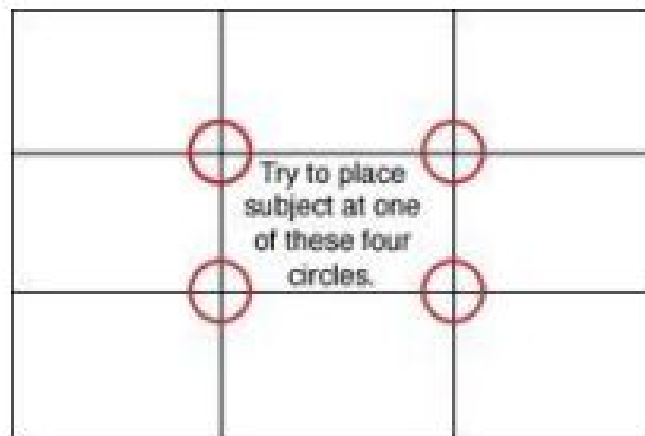
Important vocabulary!!

Subject: in photography, the subject is the object or person (or animal) that is shown in the image.

Today you will be learning about **THE RULE OF THIRDS**.
The rule of thirds is a simple guideline to help you compose your photograph so that it is more interesting for the viewer.

When looking through your camera, imagine a noughts and crosses grid, like the one below.

Try to position the subject so that it is at one of the circles and **avoid the middle!**



This week we would like you to take a photograph of someone in your family or an object using the rule of thirds!

TOP TIP

When you are taking a photograph of a person, try to position their eyes on the **top third line** like the picture below.
