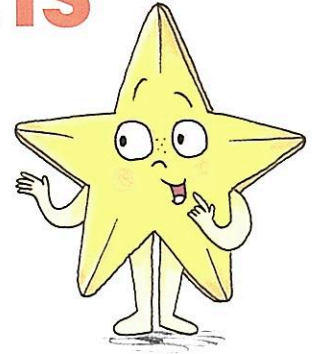


Describing actions
