WALT: use words we know to help us spell other words

Sometimes when we don't know a word, we can use other words that are like it to help us spell. This is called 'analogy' for example, you may not know how to spell *right* as in 'Is this spelling right?' However you may know how to spell *light*, so you can use that to help you to write *right*.
