WALT Write a set of instructions

Success criteria
A title and a sentence to explain what the instructions are for
Short clear sentences
A list of what is needed
Imperative verbs (get, put, slice, wash)
Steps are in chronological order (the order in which they happen)
Time words (First, secondly, finally)
Numbers or bullet points
Pictures

It has never been more important to ensure that we are washing our hands regularly and properly.

Here are just some of the times that you should wash your hands. Can you think of any more times when you should wash your hands?

- After returning from being outside
- After using the toilet
- Before eating food.
- After blowing your nose, coughing, or sneezing.
- After touching an animal or pet

You will need to write a set of instructions to help you and your family remember **HOW** to effectively wash your hands.
