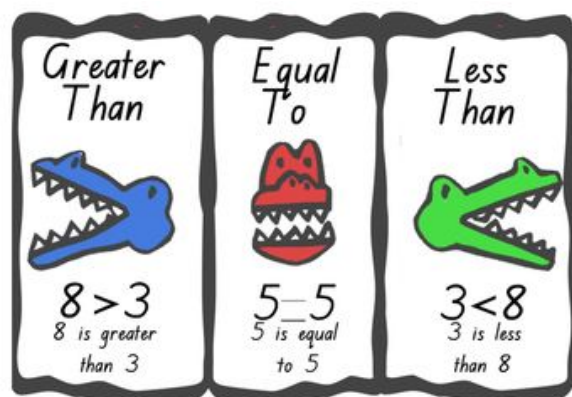
We use these signs when we are comparing numbers. Remember, the larger end points at the larger number!

$$2 < 6$$



Here you can see the larger end of the sign is pointing at the larger number!

Remember - the crocodile always eats the bigger number!



Let's see if you can compare the following numbers using $<$, $>$ or $=$

Example

$$276 \quad \square \quad 365$$

Answer:

$$276 < 365 \quad (\text{The bigger end is pointing at the bigger number!})$$
