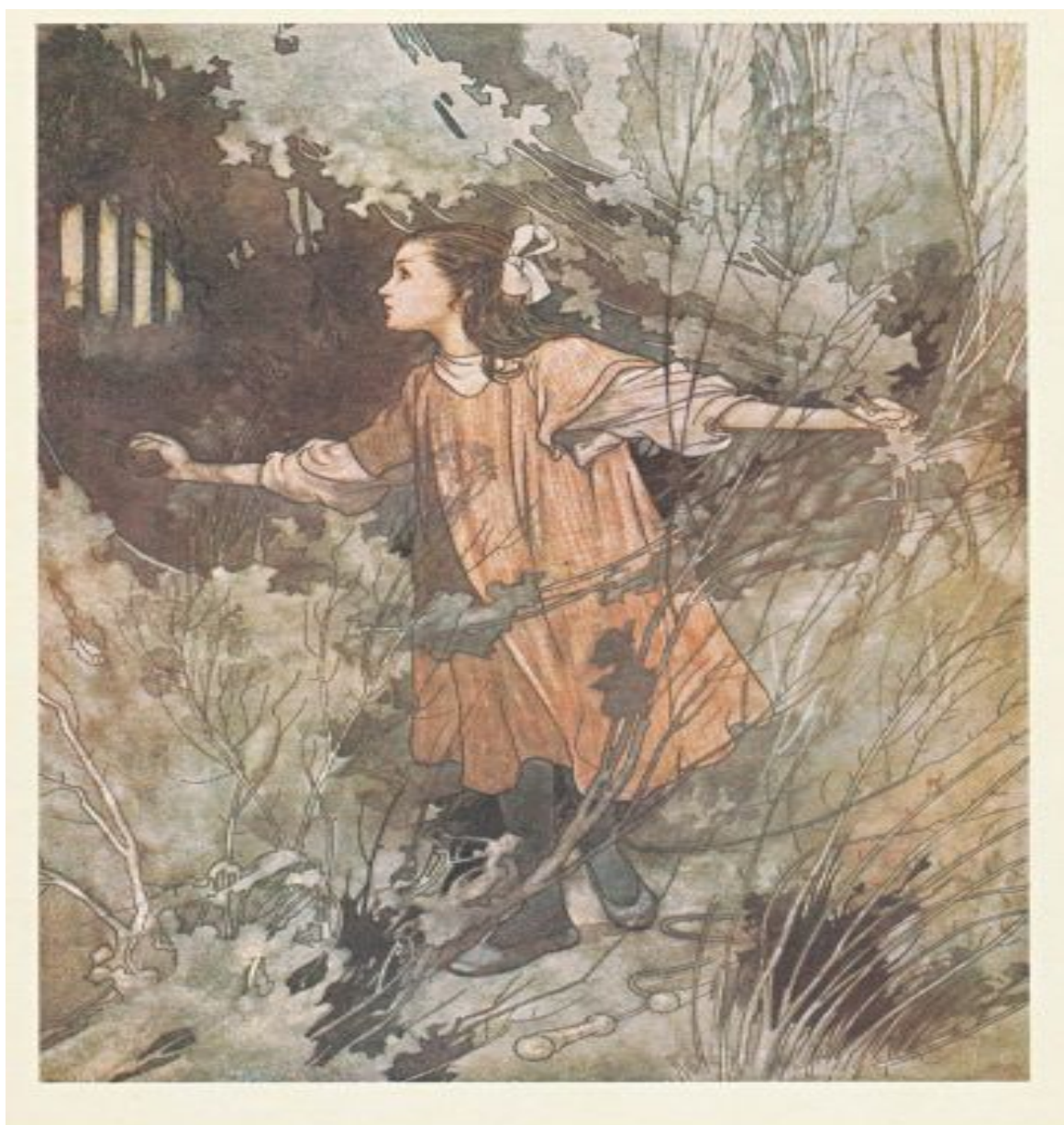
Guided reading – WALT use a picture to infer

Questions –

1. The caption to the illustration reads '***It was the knob of a door.***' What might this tell you about the girl's thoughts at that moment?
2. What do you think lay beyond the door?
3. What do you think the girl was doing before she came across the door? Look carefully at the illustration to support your answer.
4. Do you think that this story is set in modern times? Explain.
5. Thinking about the illustration, what do you think the title of the story is?

Possible Answers –
