Modern Fairytales

Last week you listened to the traditional fairytale of **Goldilocks and the Three Bears**. Pretending to be Goldilocks, you have also written a formal letter to the Bears family apologising for your behaviour at their house.

Remember there are often some features that make a fairytale! Here are some of them!

- Begins with “Once upon a time”, “Long ago”, “You must have heard the name of...”
- There is often a courageous hero/heroine in the story.
- Location of the story is an imaginary or “far away” land.
- Characters may use magic
- The story mostly concludes happily.
