<b>Kindness</b>		The story has characters who are nice to others.
<b>Acceptance</b>		The story has characters that love others who may look or think different.
<b>Perseverance</b>		The story has characters who never gave up.
<b>Learning something new</b>		The story has characters who learn something new no matter how old they are.
