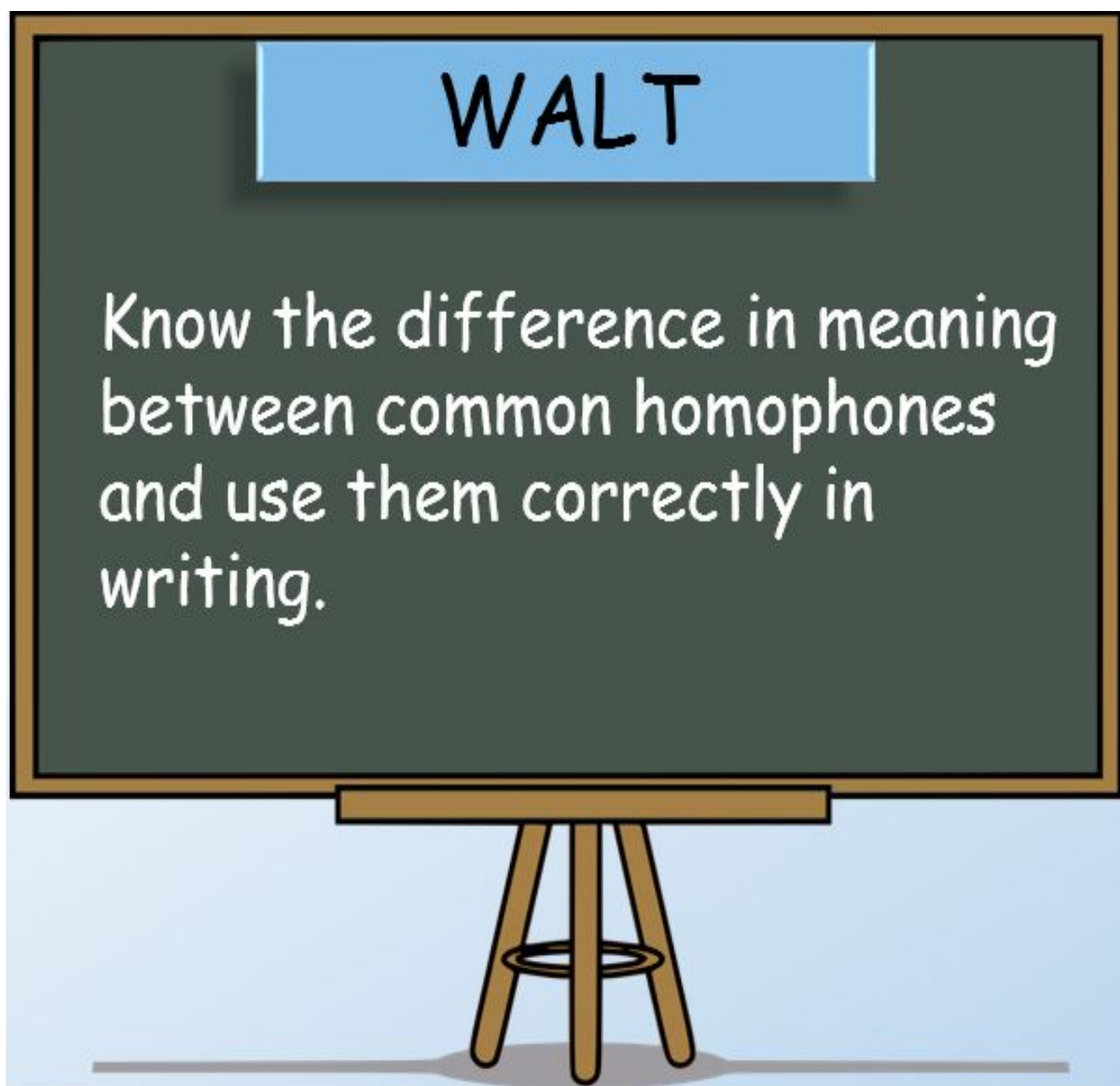


## Tuesday 9th June 2020 - Spelling

To decide which is which, remember that the noun has a 'c', while the verb has an 's'. Noun comes before verb in the alphabet: c comes before s.

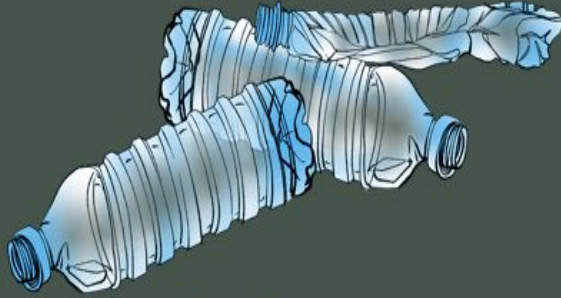
## device, devise






Advice, the noun, means an opinion given about what could be done about a situation or problem.

## advice, advise



I **advise** you to rest your ankle.



Advise, the verb, means to give an opinion about what could/should be about a situation/problem.
