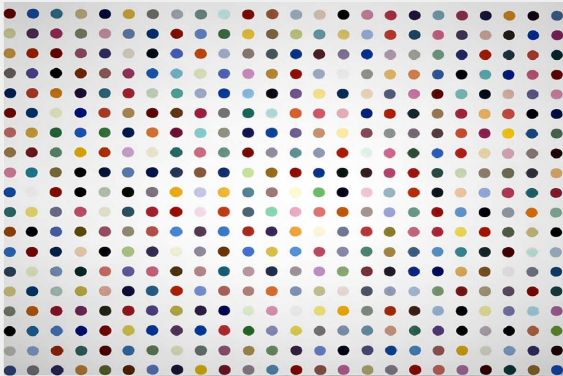

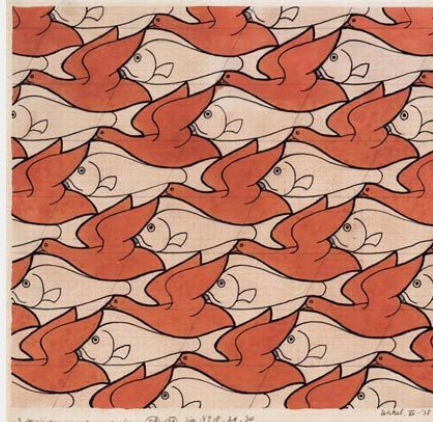
The Padlet interface also shows a "REMAKE" button, a "SHARE" button, and a "Add comment" button.

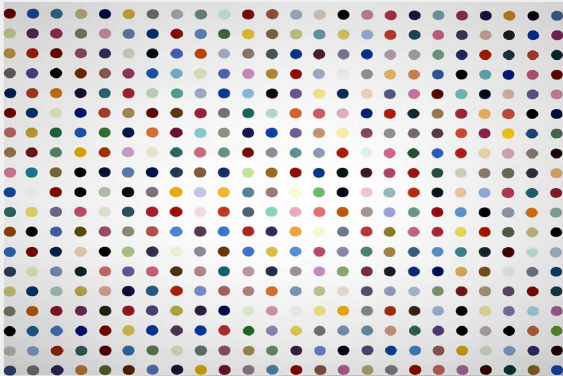

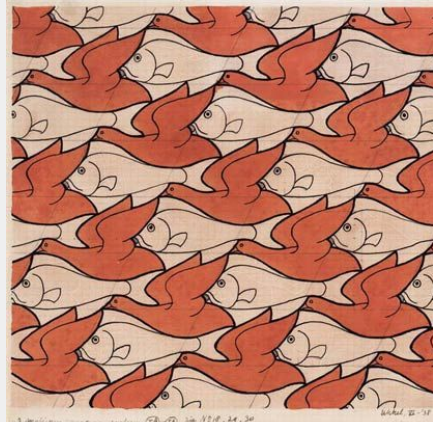
