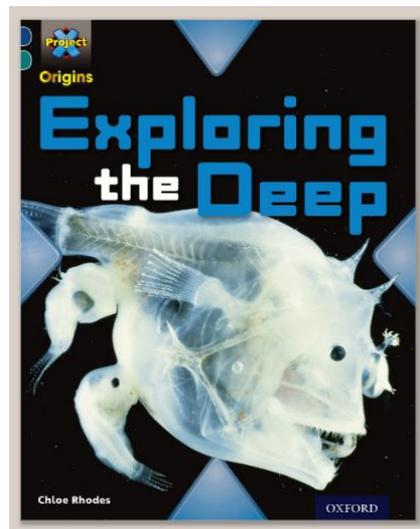

5. Find the correct book.

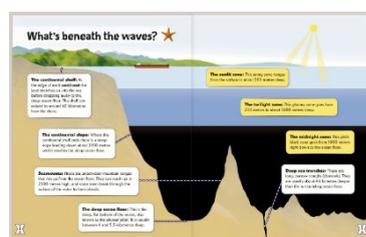
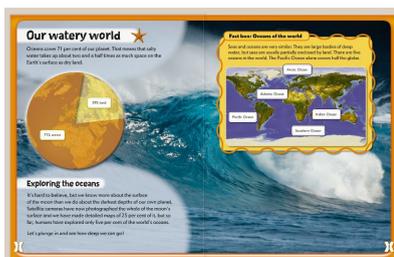
This week, we are going to read another e-book together: Exploring the Deep by Chloe Rhodes.

Answers – Task 1
